


# PLANET EARTH

**Maths** - In maths, we will be looking at place value, addition and subtraction.



**Literacy** - We will be looking at the features and structure of a non-chronological report. Then we will be writing our own report on an aquatic animal from our trip to Bristol Aquarium.

**Computing** - We will be designing our topic front covers. We will also be creating a maths game using the software *Scratch*.

**God Matters** - Our first unit is Creation which links in with our topic Planet Earth. We will be looking at stewardship and how we can endure the earth for many years to come.



**Music** - We will be exploring performance using a range of percussion instruments.

**French** - We will be revising French colours, understanding and following a short story, naming parts of the body and using adjectives to describe them.



**PE** - During PE, the children will be exploring a range of invasion games and learning different attacking and defending skills.

**PHSE** - This term we will be thinking about how we can be respectful to others.

**Topic - Planet Earth** This topic provides excellent cross-curricula opportunities, allowing the children to be scientists, where the children will be grouping and classifying living things. The children will also explore how changes to the environment can sometimes negatively impact living things. Our new topic allows the children to be geographers, the children will be using maps and atlases and learn to use grid references.



For an hour on Fridays, half of the class will be gardening with Miss Busby and the other half of the class will be with Miss Browning. Within our lesson, we will learn how to budget money which will also incorporate map work. After three weeks, the class will swap activities to develop these skills.
