#### **END OF THE DAY**

- Parents need to follow the DFE guidance on social distancing when picking up their child/ren. Please park in the same place for collection as drop off
- > Please note, we will not be offering a hot school dinner but a pack lunch that is ordered through Caterlink
- When the weather is good, the children will eat their lunch outside in their allocated zones
- When the weather is not good, tables will be wiped down in the classroom and the children will eat their lunch in their place (Marie will be in to do this to support staff)
- Each child will sit in the same place throughout the day and week
- Each child will have their own tray with their own resources that they will use throughout the week. Children will not be allowed to share resources.
- > Cloakrooms will not be used. Coats will be put on the back of the child chair, lunch box and water bottle in their tray. Trays will be on the child's own table.
- ➤ Only one child in the toilet at any one time(Staff to supervise this in KS1)
- > Children taught to wash hands thoroughly after using the toilet
- > NO BAGS ARE TO BE BROUGHT TO SCHOOL
- > All classrooms will be given a box of 'play equipment' which must remain ONLY their groups
- > Please ensure that during break time, one person makes drinks and the other wipes down chairs tables and regular touch areas. Most doors will be propped open to avoid touch regular touch.
- As agreed, homelearning for Y2,3,4,5 will remain similar to the current practice, however, no work will be submitted for marking so you must provide answer sheets. If you are differentiation to match the needs of SEND, this must continue.
- ➤ Home learning for YR, Y1 and Y6 please provide a suggested timetable. Continue to use Mymaths and Bugclub. If you wish to add PSHE resources please do. Most importantly, signpost the parents to Oak Primary Academy and BBC Bitesze

### **TEACHING STAFF**

> Timetable based on new start, break and lunch and end of day)

- ➤ Agree to regular cleaning/spray
- > All staff to bring own lunches
- > Remove all soft furnishings- no cloths, teddies, towels etc
- Agree regular cleaning of toilets/handles
- > Set out classrooms-one table per child. Child's tray/Pack of resources in trays plastic wallets one book only for any written work but this needs to be minimized
- > Agree the curriculum (Staff to have pre-read the materials WD provide from DFE on17.5.20)
- > Educate children on use of tissues (catch it, bin it, kill it)
- Posters in classrooms and toilets (Laminated)
