Come and join us for a new season of Forest School at St Joseph's Catholic Primary School. Sessions will take place on the school field every Wednesday from 3:15pm to 5pm. Our first block of six sessions will be for Key Stage 2 from Wednesday 26th February until Wednesday 1st April 2020.

Forest School is a child-led approach which aims to increase children's confidence and nurture their overall development. It provides them with the opportunity to experience appropriate risk and challenge in a natural environment. The children will be encouraged to freely choose how they spend their time and may take part in activities such as environmental art, den building, green woodworking, fire lighting, campfire cooking and climbing trees. A snack and drink is provided. Sessions are led by Katharine Piper; an experienced Forest School Leader and Early Years Teacher.

We like to keep our groups small and therefore spaces are limited to twelve. We charge £8 a session and spaces are allocated on a first come first served basis. A commitment to this six week block is required and a payment of £48 can be made via Bacs to K E Piper 07-08-06 12603247 (please note change of details). This commitment helps to ensure the progression of skills and allows for new friendships to form. It also enables us to resource and plan appropriately.

If you would like to secure a space, please make your payment and return the attached slip to the office by Friday 14th February. Please also ensure you complete and return the attached Medical Consent and Registration form. This information will be kept confidential and destroyed at the end of the booking period.
