## Home learning writing ideas:

## Poetry:

Try taking a normal, everyday object like the examples below and write a piece of poetry about it including lots of similes and alliteration.

tree shoe foot hand ball pencil sea sun

Alliteration = when 2 or more words that are next to each other start with the same letter/sound. For example: the grumpy, grouchy, grey goose grabbed green grass in its beak.

Similes = using 'like' or 'as' to compare 2 things. Making sure you exaggerate the thing you are comparing is important. For example: The paper floated away as free as a bird.

## Warning tales:

You could try writing your own warning tale. Remember the following structure features to follow -

Opening - setting the scene, introduce main characters and the situation they are in.

Build up - something happens that means they need to go on a journey

Problem - something goes wrong and MC in some kind of trouble

Resolution - the problem is solved somehow

Ending - MC's journey comes to an end and all is well
