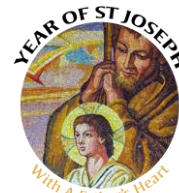

If your child signs up to a club is it important that you understand it is a commitment for the whole term and they should attend each week. If a child misses a session without a valid reason they will not be allowed to continue. Only children who are on a club's register will be able to take part, we cannot accommodate children watching on the side. Please ensure you are on time to collect your child/ren. If parents/carers are late on more than 3 occasions, then children will no longer be able to come to the club.

Children should wear the school PE kit for after school activities - no home clothes please. Children who take part in cross-country can wear running trousers and base layer under their house t-shirt and will be allowed to wear jackets and hi-viz on top of their PE kits.

Cross-country club - it is expected that all children who attend this club take part in the races at KLB School. We are hopeful that there will be some races after Christmas.
