Policy Statement for St Joseph's Out of School Club

We will endeavour to adopt an 'Open door policy' to ensure staff, pupils and parents feel St Joseph's Out of School Club is welcoming of communication and discussion and our services and information are fully accessible.

Families are welcome to visit the Out of School Club and are encouraged to make suggestions on our service programs, philosophy, policies, procedures, practices and management.

- Attendance at organised committee meetings.
- Reviewing and providing input into service policies and procedures.
- Feedback of the service
- Taking on voluntary committee roles which ensure the continued running of the Out of School Club

St Joseph's Out of School Club is aware that as parents/carers with young children life is pretty full on, and Out of School Club allows time away from the child/children to get on with other things, whether it be working or doing the weekly shop. That is why we have planned events throughout the year with parents/carers.
