

SATS work and revision pack

Just a little note home to firstly say what another wonderfully busy term we have had. The children have been pushing themselves in all areas and trying to be the best that they can be!

Soon after the Easter holidays the Year 6's will be sitting their KS2 SATs – the week commencing 9th May 2022. After all their hard work this year, we do not want them to forget all that work over the break! If they do a little bit of SPaG (Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar), Maths and Reading every day it will keep things fresh in their mind for when they come back to school.

By using the packs that I have sourced, they will be using the key skills they have been rehearsing all year. It is called **10-4-10 '10 minutes for 10 days.'** Everyday there are different SATS style questions, relating to the 3 different subject areas mentioned above. Please could your children try to do as much of the booklets as they can, remember it should take around 10 minutes each day for each subject, so 30 minutes in total. If your child/children struggle with anything, please make sure they ask Mrs Hamlin or me when they return to school.

I have also included: a Year 3/4 and 5/6 statutory spellings sheet; a set of Maths practice papers; a Key Stage 2 knowledge organiser for Maths; a Maths quiz; and a SPaG Glossary for parents.

On a side note, during SATS week I will be running a breakfast club, which I will send a letter about when we return to school after the Easter break.
