OFSTED INSPECTION – JUNE 2018.

OOSC received a GOOD rating

Ofsted inspected OOSC on the 6th June this year and reviewed the service being provided. Typically, the inspection came three days after our move into the Leigh building, but this didn't impact on the findings in any way, so huge congratulations to the OOSC team – this is testament to the hard work and the efficiency with which the move was executed.

The inspection involved the inspector discussing the running of the club with the Committee and OOSC team, observing children's activities, reviewing documentation and talking to parents and children. They were particularly impressed by the range of activities available and the outside play facilities that the children can use as they wish.

We are proud to have received a **GOOD** rating across the three areas of assessment (effectiveness of the leadership and management, quality of teaching, learning and assessment and Personal development, behaviour and welfare.)

To improve our rating for the next inspection, the team will be focusing on the following areas:

- Greater alignment with the themes being studied by the school, with these being amplified across the activities provided by OOSC
- Greater involvement of the children in the preparation and serving of their snacks.

Thank you to all the parents and children who took the time to speak to the inspector and share your views of OOSC with her. This is a key part in the assessment and your positive comments are very much valued by the OOSC team and Committee.



Could your child attend St Joseph's if OOSC didn't exist?

The OOSC provision is at serious risk of closure, unless we have a volunteer for the role of **Treasurer** by the end of the Summer Term, enabling a period of handover before the new Treasurer takes on the role fully at Christmas. We are also seeking and at least one other **non-positioned committee member** to join the committee immediately.

The Treasurer role may sound daunting, but our current treasurer has been streamlining what is required for this role. With the introduction of the online booking system, the role is further still reduced. Helen will work with you to bring you up to speed during your handover period, so you will be in very safe hands.

In terms of the non-positioned role, the level of commitment required isattendance at a committee meeting every half term and helping source items/activities as required.

The OOSC provision is a highly valued asset at St Joseph's and we know from recent questionnaires that without this facility, some children simply wouldn't be able to attend the school. If you need OOSC for your children to attend St Joseph's, please don't wait for someone else to step forward as this may not happen. Closure is a very real risk and it would be a very sad day for all at St Josephs if this were to happen.
