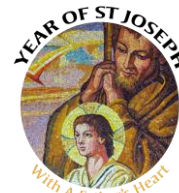

Dear parents/carers,

Year 6 will be completing their SATs during the week beginning the 10th May. We are trying to make the end of their year as 'normal' as possible for them. From Monday – Thursday we will be providing a special breakfast for the children when they arrive at school, before they take a test. Due to the tests this year being internal, the breakfast will run during school hours from 8:40am onwards.

In the morning, we are intending to walk from school to Woodchester Mansion Play Trail and spend our day around the mansion grounds. For those of you who have not visited the site before, at the woodland Play Trail we'll expect to find wobble beams, stepping logs, a see-saw, wooden hop-scotch, balance bridges, rope swings and of course a climbing frame or two.

Please could you send your child into school that day with a picnic lunch. The children will need to carry this on our walk so a backpack is most advisable.
