A reminder of the fees for OOSC:


- Breakfast club (Monday-Friday) This will include breakfast.

- After school club (Monday-Friday) This will include snacks.
 - o 15:15 till 18:00
 - £7.50 Contracted bookings
 - Ad-hoc bookings
 - 15.15pm 16:30 £7.00
 - 15:15 18:00 £10.00
- We now also take pre-schoolers that are potty trained from 3 years old.
