How can you help?

Look out for texts from the school office, Facebook posts, and letters in book bags that detail our fund-raising events and the 'sign-up' web links that enable you to volunteer to help with small, specific aspects of each event.

In addition, you can help in the following ways:

- Volunteer to be a class rep, and help us to ensure that parents associated with each year group are aware of the planned activities and how to help out at each event. Help us spread the word through your parent Facebook pages or WhatsApp groups. No need to be on the committee, just keep in touch with us to share the messages. We need a class rep for Reception, and Years 3, 5 and 6.
- Secure match funding from your employer by contributing your time to supporting our fund-raising activities. We know that many employers will provide charitable match funding in support of their employees own fund raising for good causes. Simply find out how your scheme works and talk to us to determine how we can make it work best for St Joseph's.
- **Contribute through your own skills**.
