Topic

Reading

I am looking forward to hearing about any of the books that the class received over Christmas – they can also bring these in to read. As always, we continue to have a big push for reading. It is so important in Year 6 as it helps to prepare them for the expectations at secondary school as well as the SATS tests in May. We would love all of the class to read 5 times per week to an adult outside of school as well as to read by themselves e.g. before bed. You are able to document this in the children's yellow reading diaries (they can also write in these), both Miss Hall and I keep a close eye on these and any children fulfilling this task will be rewarded with a stamp towards their reading awards.

Homework

A reminder about homework. This really helps to develop children's ability to cope with homework in preparation for secondary school.

Saint David's homework will be set on a Friday (online on Teams) and this will include:

- Spellings (green book) These will need to be practised at home ready for a test every Thursday.
- Maths, English or topic based work. This all needs to be completed and handed back in on the following Wednesday.
