Reminders

Homework will be set through TEAMs on a Friday, this will include:

- Spellings- these will be shared as before through TEAMS, and to be practised alongside their homework. Please make sure green spellings books are in school by Thursdays at the latest.
- Homework usually has a main focus on maths, English, comprehension, RE or topic.
